Overview

Welcome to the PRINCE2® Foundation 7th Edition course!

This course provides a good overview of the world's most widely used project management method, PRINCE2® - 7th edition. It focuses on the principles, processes and practices of this method and teaches participants how to fully apply PRINCE2® with examples and exercises.

This course is governed by the PRINCE2® Examination Syllabus, which details the topics which must be covered by courses accredited to provide training and prepare candidates for the examinations in PRINCE2®.

Target audience

This course is aimed at all members of a project team (administrators, coordinators, managers), aspiring project managers, practicing project managers, and program managers. Due to the generic nature of this course, it is also suitable for general managers, staff in a supporting role, and those who wish to gain formal recognition of their skills by taking the PRINCE2 Foundation examination or professionals looking for generic fundamental project management skills.

Exam information

The exam is conducted online via remote proctoring. Upon the commencement of the course, students will receive an email invitation to register on the PeopleCert portal. Once registered, they can book their online exam at a date and time that suits them. It is the student's responsibility to schedule their exam.

Exam Format:

- Type: Multiple choice
- Duration: 60 minutes
- Mode: Closed book
- Passing Mark: 60% (36 out of 60)
