Exam information

The exam is conducted online via remote proctoring. Upon the commencement of the course, students will receive an email invitation to register on the PeopleCert portal. Once registered, they can book their online exam at a date and time that suits them. It is the student's responsibility to schedule their exam.

Exam Format:

PRINCE2® 7 Foundation exam

- Type: Multiple choice
- Duration: 60 minutes
- Mode: Closed book
- Passing Mark: 60% (36 out of 60)

PRINCE2® 7 Practitioner exam

- Type: Multiple choice
- Duration: 150 minutes
- Mode: Open book
- Passing Mark: 60% (42 out of 70)

Please note: We would like to inform you that during **PRINCE2® 7 Practitioner** open book exam candidates can use only official hard copy books or softcopy e-books on a secondary device. More information you can read <u>here.</u>
